



Summer School Options



PGS has revamped its summer school program!

This summer Pawnee Grade School will offer two summer school options for families with students in kindergarten through 6th grade. Students can attend both camps if they would like!

Transportation: Parents are responsible for making all transportation arrangements. No district transportation is available for summer school.

Title I Reading Program

The summer school reading program is intended to be an intervention for students who are not reading at grade level. Students will be invited to attend this program if they are currently reading at a level that is significantly below grade level. The students will be grouped by level and the instructional program will be highly differentiated to meet the individual student's needs.

The reading intervention program that will be utilized is called LLI (Leveled Literacy Intervention). This scientifically research based program provides intensive instruction with the goal of bringing your student to grade level in 18-24 weeks time. Students using this program during summer school will continue to benefit from it during the regular school year as part of their Rtl Plan.

If your student is just slightly below grade level or if you would simply like your student to have an opportunity to maintain his/her reading skills you may also register him/her to attend this program. These students will not use the LLI Program. Instead they will be provided instruction at their levels so that they too may continue to grow as readers.

Please note: Spaces in the summer reading program are limited. Stu-

dents will be placed according to need first.

Fees: There are *no* fees for this program.

Math Camp

Math Camp is open to all students entering 4th, 5th, or 6th grade. Students attending the Math Camp will be provided opportunities to both practice their basic skills AND experience math enrichment activities! This program is intended for students who need a little extra practice, as well as for those students who enjoy math and would benefit from some fun math games and activities. The math games are intended to be for enrichment and challenge!

Fees: The fee for attending the Math Camp is \$55. Students eligible for the Free/Reduced Lunch Program will be charged a reduced fee, or be free of charge.
