Curtis & Frances Hoppin Scholarship Application

Scholarship Description: The Curtis & Frances Hoppin Scholarships are one-time awards. One scholarship is awarded to a student planning to attend a two-year college before transferring to a four-year college to complete a bachelor’s degree. The other scholarship is awarded to a student planning to enter a four-year college or university directly from high school for completion of a bachelor’s degree.

Eligibility: Any Pawnee High School senior who has applied to an accredited two-year or four-year college or university may apply for these scholarships. The applicants must begin their college/university studies beginning in the fall semester of the academic year following high school graduation.

Documents to Submit:

- Scholarship Applicant Information Form
- Official High school transcript with test scores
- College transcript (applicable if you have taken college courses while in high school)
- Letters of reference from two high school teachers
- 300 word essay about yourself and how your community and extra-curricular activities and/or work experience have prepared you for your college and career goals.

Criteria Used to Evaluate Applicants:

- Grade Point Average (weighted)
- Courses taken
- ACT or SAT test score
- Community and extra-curricular activities and/or work experience
- Character
- Financial need
