

#### **Good News Report:**

#### Living a Mission and Vision Focused on Results:

- New Teacher Orientation was hosted at Pawnee on Thursday, August 11. This afforded new teachers the opportunity to learn more about our systems and processes as well as meet their mentor for this school year. Breakfast was provided by the school and lunch was provided by the teacher's union.
- Teacher Mentor Program: I am currently working alongside our union to develop an informal teacher mentoring program that will be initiated this school year as an informal pilot. This program will include monthly checklists of common teacher driven activities that the mentor & mentee will complete together as well as a cross-observational experience.

#### Leading and Managing Systems Change:

- **CPI Training**: Ensured that both JH & HS paraprofessional and teachers, as well as myself, received updated CPI (Crisis Prevention Intervention) training for the 22/23 school year.
- GoGuardian: Looking ahead at professional development, teachers are
  requesting more information and training on GoGuardian-the software utilized to
  monitor student computer use on our chromebooks. An email will be distributed
  to our current educators asking for teacher-leaders who would be willing to guide
  their peers in more advanced uses of that software.

# Improving Teaching and Learning:

• Teacher Walk-Through Form: I have completed a new form in our teacher evaluation program, Evaluwise, that will assist administrators and teachers through an informal walk-through observation. This form assists with successful documentation of each instructional components under Goal Domain #2 (The Classroom Environment) & Domain #3 (Instruction).

  - **Trauma-Informed-Leading**: Trauma-informed care recognizes and responds to the signs, symptoms, and risks of trauma to better support the health needs of student who have experienced Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs) and toxic stress. Trauma-informed care is a framework that involves: Understanding the prevalence of trauma and their impacts on health and behavior; Recognizing the effects of trauma and adversity on health and behavior; Training leadership with best practices; Integrating knowledge into policies, procedures, and practices

    - Unit in "Title A107" room to be operational by mid-week (power/breakers today, mech final connections today/tomorrow).
    - Other units installed, power/breakers completed today, however still waiting on ship date for the central controller. No further update on shipping known as of today, so still assuming 8/31 based on last known estimate from a 7/7 email.
  - Canopy
    - Waiting for confirmed ship date/lead time, but anticipating after first of 2023 still.
    - Working on receiving engineered drawings for the foundation, so not able to perform any demo or new concrete work before school starts as was previously planned. Since the canopy is still some ways out, they're considering the best timing for a new plan of attack out here.
  - Door/Frame Replacements
    - Unfortunately, suppliers were not able to provide the HM doors/frames/hdwr in time for installation before school as previously planned (adjustments during submittals and dimension confirmations

extended the lead times), so they are working on a phasing plan to present and review with you to see how they can work on the various openings during the school year.

- They're assuming some would likely be no issue during school, while others will require some re-routing, if acceptable, or even just have to wait for a long weekend or break period. They will be flexible to accommodate your schedule and timing.
