

Living a Mission and Vision Focused on Results:

• Mid-year evaluation data is being discussed and recorded based upon individual teachers for student learning objectives.

Leading and Managing Systems Change:

• I have been working hard with Mrs. Hyde to ready our classes for second semester. The addition of our chorus teacher as well as the fulfillment of our physical education position has helped broaden and sustain our options for the second semester. Additionally, the science position remains open in the hope to meet next year's needs. Until then, we continue to work with the certifications and strengths within our own staff as well as utilizing online options.

Improving Teaching and Learning:

 I have been working closely with our teachers to become more proficient at adapting homework, quizzes, tests and finals in alignment with IEP and 504 accommodations. The special education team has created a list of appropriate accommodations and modifications.

Building and Maintaining Collaborative Relationships:

• We are in early planning phases with a partnership and grant from SIU Medicine for a Crash Reenactment that will be occuring in the spring of 2023. This presentation will be in additional partnership with the township of Pawnee emergency response team. There are 5 chosen schools in the midwest and Pawnee was chosen to be one of those five. This simulation's goal is to drive home the consequences of distracted driving and driving under the influence.

Leading with Integrity and Professionalism:

- Rob Moorehead from the Pawnee Lion's Club contacted us to extend the canned food drive for the community Christmas baskets. We held a non-perishable food drive as a competition between 7,8,8,9,10,11, and 12th grades! Together, we were both competitive and generous and presented the Lion's Club with 1,297 items! The freshman class provided the most items and received a pizza party sponsored by our very own Lion's Club!
- Pawnee Junior Beta Club hosted its annual Charity week on Oct. 24-28. Each day was a different dress up day, and Junior Beta Club members collected donations from grades pre-K. In all more than \$850 was collected. Beta Club then sent \$450 to St. Louis Children's Hospital and \$450 to American Cancer Society.


