- Good News I want to thank Tanya Walker (24), Eleanor VanDeventer (22), and Scott MacDonald (27) for all of their years of service to the district.
- Finance The latest CPPRT payment came through and it was a massive payment of \$761,086. I am not sure where the state came up with the money for the last two payments, but we will gladly take it. Also the County Facility Sales Tax money continues to come in. We are \$93,517 over what we had budgeted for the year.
- Curriculum Graduation is Friday May 21st at 7:00 pm in the varsity gym. At this moment we have 42 graduates with 4 more waiting on final grades to be turned in to see if they graduate. So we could have a total of 46 graduates. 8th Grade Promotion is on Thursday May 27th in the varsity gym at 7:00 pm. The 8th graders and juniors have completed the Illinois Science Assessment and the 7th and 8th graders have completed the Illinois Readiness Assessment.
- Legislative The Governor has asked for an increase in EBF for next year. We will have to wait and see what comes out at the end of the month.
- CDC has released new guidelines for wearing masks. At this time we have been told by the health department that schools are to continue to wear masks until further guidelines are developed.
