

Advertisement for a Paraprofessional for Pawnee Grade School:

Pawnee Grade School is currently hiring a paraprofessional for the 2022-23 school year. Applicants must be 19 years of age or older. There are different pathways for obtaining a paraprofessional license. To obtain a license one must have a bachelor's degree or higher OR 60 semester hours of college coursework OR high school diploma and passing score on ACT Work Keys Test OR passing score on ETS ParaPro Test. Interested applicants must also have the ability to pass a fingerprint background check. In addition, paraprofessionals will maintain CPI certification, provided by the district upon hire.

Paraprofessionals must have effective oral communication and interpersonal skills, and the willingness to make positive contributions in a team atmosphere. S/he must establish and maintain effective working relationships with colleagues. Interested candidates will assist teachers in providing a positive, safe, and academically challenging learning environment for students. Paraprofessionals assist teachers/supervisors in all areas, which may include assistance with specific components of an IEP (relating directly to children assigned) and monitoring safety conditions for students. S/he will contribute to the home/school communication process under the direction and supervision of the teacher and/or administration. For the 2022-2023 school year the Paraprofessional pay rate is \$15.69 per hour.
