Baccalaureate practice and cookout will be at 11:15am at PAG on Wednesday, May 11. The baccalaureate and parade of graduates will be on Sunday, May 15 at 4:00pm at the Pawnee Assembly of God Church. The parade of graduates will immediately follow the baccalaureate ceremony. Attending the baccalaureate ceremony is optional as you do not have to attend to participate in the parade of graduates. If you do not attend baccalaureate but would like to be in the parade, please arrive at PAG by 4:30pm.

Please email me a formal picture and a baby picture you would like on the posters that will be given to you for your car for the parade of graduates. If you do not email any pictures, I will use the senior formal and baby pictures given to the yearbook. Please email me in a jpeg format by Friday, April 29.

Formal graduation photos as well as ceremony photos will be taken by Ed Clark Photography. An email will be sent to you with information on ordering and paying for graduation photos. Formal graduation pictures will begin at 6:00pm in the high school gym on graduation night. The class photo will be taken at 6:30pm. Professional attire is expected for participation in graduation and baccalaureate ceremonies. The following are not allowed: shorts, T-shirts, jeans, tennis shoes, flip flops. Shirts with collars are preferred.

Students may decorate the top of their hats with no items hanging off the sides. Any hats that are decorated must be preapproved by Mr. Kratochvil. Hats that are not preapproved will not be worn during the ceremony. Any type of celebratory objects such as silly string, celebration poppers, or noise makers are prohibited in the gym. Students that are caught with any of these items will be removed from the graduation line-up and not allowed to participate in the graduation ceremony.
